AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXPENSE AND SUPPORT OF A PRISONER AWAITING TRANSFER FROM A JAIL TO A CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 127 of the General Laws is amended by adding a new
2 section 126A.

3 The expense of supporting a prisoner awaiting transfer from a
4 jail or house of correction to a correctional institution of the
5 Commonwealth shall be paid by the commonwealth acting
6 through its commissioner of corrections.
