AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POWERS OF THE SHERIFF OF SUFFOLK COUNTY  
OVER THE APPOINTMENT OF STANDING OR SPECIAL COMMISSIONERS  
TO TAKE BAIL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 57 of chapter 276 is amended by deleting the words “or,
- 2 in the county of Suffolk, by the sheriff of said county”, and it is
- 3 further amended by deleting the fourth sentence of such section.
