AN ACT REDEFINING CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR CERTAIN ELECTED OFFICIALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (1) of section 4 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out paragraph (a) and inserting in
3 place thereof the following: —

4 (a) Any member in service shall, subject to the provisions and
5 limitations of sections one to twenty-eight inclusive, be credited
6 with all service rendered by him as an employee in any governmen-
7 tal unit after becoming a member of the system pertaining thereto;
8 provided, [that he shall be credited with a year of creditable service
9 for each calendar year during which he served as an elected official;
10 and provided, further,] that in no event shall he be credited with
11 more than one year of creditable service for all such membership
12 service rendered during any one calendar year.
