AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE DUTIES OF THE TREASURER AND THE REMOVAL THEREOF RELATIVE TO BEING INCAPACITATED BY REASON OF MENTAL ILLNESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as so
2 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out of line one the word: — “insane”, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following section: — “incapacitated by reason of men-
5 tal illness”.

1 SECTION 2. Section 17 of Chapter 10, of the General Laws, as
2 so appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby further amend-
3 ed by striking out of line three the following: — “insane, feeble-
4 minded, and epileptic”, and inserting in place thereof the following
5 words: — “mentally ill or mentally retarded”.
