AN ACT REQUIRING DOG LICENSES TO BE ISSUED TO SOMEONE EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section one hundred and thirty-seven of Chapter one hundred
- 2 and forty of the General Laws as most recently amended by section
- 3 one of Chapter seventy-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and
- 4 fifty-six is hereby further amended by adding the following: —
- 5 Any license issued under the provision of this section shall not be
- 6 issued to a person under eighteen years of age.
