By Mr. Flynn of Bridgewater, petition of Peter Y. Flynn, Joseph W. McCarthy and others (county commissioners of Plymouth County) that said commissioners be authorized to implement the unfunded portions of the collective bargaining agreement between the International Brotherhood of Correction Officers and Plymouth County Public Service.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSIONERS OF PLYMOUTH COUNTY TO IMPLEMENT THE UNFUNDED PORTIONS OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF CORRECTION OFFICERS AND THE COUNTY OF PLYMOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Treasurer, with the approval of the County
2 Commissioners, is hereby authorized to pay the unfunded portions
3 of the collective bargaining agreement between the County of
4 Plymouth and the International Brotherhood of Correction Offi-
5 cers for the period July 1, 1978 through June 30, 1980, and to raise
6 from available funds the amount of Forty Nine Thousand, Five
7 Hundred Fifty-Three (\$49,553.00) Dollars for the purpose.

1 SECTION 2. This Act will take effect on passage.
