

By Mr. Flynn of Bridgewater, petition of Peter Y. Flynn that employees of the Department of Correction be transferred from the Executive Office of Human Services to the Executive Office of Public Safety. Public Service.

AN ACT TRANSFERRING DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION EMPLOYEES FROM THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF HUMAN SERVICES TO THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 All officers and employees of the department of correction
2 executive office of human services who, immediately prior to
3 the effective date of this act, hold positions classified under
4 chapter thirty-one of the General Laws, or have tenure in
5 their positions by reason of section nine A of chapter thirty
6 of the General Laws, shall continue to be officers and em-
7 ployees of the department of correction in the executive office
8 of public safety without impairment of civil service status,
9 seniority, retirement and other employment rights, and
10 without interruption of service within the meaning of said
11 chapter thirty-one or said section nine A, and without reduc-
12 tion in compensation and salary grade.

13 All officers and employees of the department of correction
14 who, immediately prior to said effective date do not hold
15 positions classified under said chapter thirty-one, or do not
16 have tenure in their positions by reason of said section nine
17 A, shall continue to be officers and employees of the depart-
18 ment of correction in the executive office of public safety
19 under this act without impairment of seniority, retirement
20 and other rights, and without interruption of service within
21 the meaning of said section nine A and said chapter thirty-
22 one, and without reduction in compensation and salary grade.

23 Nothing in this section shall be construed to confer upon
24 any officer or employee any rights not held prior to said
25 effective date, or to prohibit any subsequent reduction in
26 compensation or salary grade not prohibited prior thereto.
