AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN HOME IMPROVEMENTS FROM LOCAL PROPERTY TAXATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by adding the following clause: —
- 3 Forty-five, Capital improvements including but not limited to
- 4 renovations, additions, and landscapings shall be tax exempt for a
- 5 period of five years from the date of permit. This clause shall apply
- 6 only to owner occupied dwellings.
- 7 This act shall take affect upon approval of the City Council and
- 8 Mayor or town meeting or Board of Selectmen.
