AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF TEWKSBURY TO ESTABLISH A REVOLVING BANK ACCOUNT FOR THE BOARD OF HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The town of Tewksbury is hereby authorized to establish a
2 revolving bank account for exclusive use of the board of health of
3 said town. The board may deposit into said account moneys col-
4 lected as fees from health clinics and other programs and activities
5 of the board and may make expenditures and disbursements from
6 said account for the purpose of sponsoring and conducting health
7 clinics and other such programs and activities.
