AN ACT REQUIRING LOCAL APPROVAL FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OR ALTERATION OF MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FACILITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 5 of chapter 161A of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following subsection: —

3 *C11.* The construction, reconstruction or alteration of Massa-  
4 chusetts Bay Transportation Authority facilities shall be subject to  
5 a majority vote approval of the city council, in the case of a city, or  
6 a majority vote approval of the town meeting, in the case of a town,  
7 where the facilities are, or will be located.
