

for their use and permit them to use suitable seats while they are at work, except in such cases and at such times as the work cannot properly be performed in a sitting position. Whoever violates the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten nor more than thirty dollars for each offence.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR FAILURE OF BANKS TO FILE RETURNS WITH THE BANK COMMISSIONER. Chap. 97

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section thirteen of chapter five hundred and ninety of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and eight is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the words:—Any bank neglecting to make the returns required by law or by the bank commissioner, or failing to amend such report within fifteen days after notice from the bank commissioner, shall forfeit to the commonwealth five dollars for each day during which such neglect continues, to be recovered by an information in equity in the name of the attorney-general at the relation of the bank commissioner, brought in the supreme judicial court for the county of Suffolk, — so as to read as follows:—

*Section 13.* In addition to the reports required by law to be made, such banks shall make such other statements and reports to the commissioner as he may require. The commissioner shall furnish blank forms for all statements or reports required to be made to him. Any bank neglecting to make the returns required by law or by the bank commissioner, or failing to amend such report within fifteen days after notice from the bank commissioner, shall forfeit to the commonwealth five dollars for each day during which such neglect continues, to be recovered by an information in equity in the name of the attorney-general at the relation of the bank commissioner, brought in the supreme judicial court for the county of Suffolk.
