RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE SOLICITATION METHODS UTILIZED BY RELIGIOUS AND CHARITABLE GROUPS.

Resolved, That a special commission to consist of three 2 members of the Senate, five members of the House of Representatives, the Secretary of State or his designee, the Attorney General or his designee and two persons to be appointed by the Governor is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative to the solicitation methods utilized by religious and charitable groups and organizations in the Commonwealth and, in the course of its investigation and study, shall consider all relevant statutes, regulations and procedures pertaining to the granting, 9 withholding and voiding of Certificates of Incorporation to 10 religious and charitable groups or institutions and to the statutes, 11 regulations and procedures pertaining to the methods utilized by said groups and organizations in the solicitation, use and disposal 13 of funds 14

Said Commission shall consider whether modifications of said statutes, regulations or procedures are desirable in order to protect the public interest.

Said Commission may involve in advisory roles such persons, groups and organizations, public or private, as it deems appropriate.

Said Commission shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the House of
