AN ACT AMENDING THE HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 94B, section 3 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by adding after subsection (C) the following new subsection: —
- 3 (H). No person shall sell any product that is required by state or
- 4 federal law to carry a health hazard warning label unless such label
- 5 also has printed thereon in a conspicuous manner the universal
- 6 symbol of danger . . . the skull and crossbones.
