AN ACT REQUIRING TELEPHONE COMPANIES TO LIST CALLS MADE ON "BAY STATE SERVICE" ON MONTHLY BILLINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Every telephone company doing business in the commonwealth
- 2 which offers to its customers bay state service, so-called, shall list on
- 3 monthly billing statements all telephone calls made under such
- 4 service in the sequence in which they were made.
