AN ACT PROVIDING THAT SENTENCES IMPOSED UNDER THE MANDATORY GUN LAW SHALL BE SERVED ON AND AFTER ANY OTHER SENTENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 10 of Chapter 269 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding after paragraph (1) the following
- 3 paragraph:—
- 4 (m) Sentences imposed under this section shall be served on and
- 5 after any other sentence imposed by any court, and shall not be
- 6 concurrent with them.
