AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF FACTFINDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section nine of Chapter 150E, of the General
2 Laws, is hereby amended by striking out in the second sentence of
3 the fourth paragraph of said section the following words: — “A list
4 of qualified persons . . .”, and is further amended by inserting in
5 place thereof the following words: “The Massachusetts Arbitration
6 Association”, which shall be a Massachusetts corporation or busi-
7 ness association.

1 SECTION 2. Said section is further amended by striking out
2 the third sentence of the fourth paragraph.
