AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NUMBER AND COMPOSITION OF MEMBERS ON THE ADVISORY BOARD ON LEGISLATIVE AND CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS' COMPENSATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 162 of chapter 6 of
2 the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 1172 of the
3 acts of 1973, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line two,
4 the word "seven" and inserting in place thereof, the word: — nine.

1 SECTION 2. The first paragraph of section 162 of chapter 6 of
2 the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1172 of the
3 acts of 1973, is hereby further amended by inserting after the first
4 sentence the following sentence: —

5 One member shall be a nominee of Common Cause of Massa-
6 chusetts, or any successor organization, one member shall be a
7 nominee of the League of Women Voters of Massachusetts, or any
8 successor organization.
