AN ACT EXTENDING THE DUTIES OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE BUREAU OF WELFARE AUDITING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 7, Section 30T of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting in subsection (2) "division of industrial accidents,
- 3 state retirement board" after the department of public welfare, so
- 4 that subsection (2) of Section 30T shall read:
- 5 (2) Examine the records and accounts of the department of
- 6 public welfare, division of industrial accidents, state retirement
- 7 board, division of employment security and veteran's services, and
- 8 for such purposes the Director shall have access to such records
- 9 and accounts at reasonable times and may require the production
- 10 of books, documents and vouchers relating to any matter within
- 11 the scope of such investigation;
