AN ACT RELATIVE TO SUMMER EMPLOYMENT FOR CERTAIN PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any special or general law to
2 the contrary, all in-school Massachusetts youths between the ages
3 of fourteen and twenty-four, shall be guaranteed summer job
4 opportunities whether in existing programs or newly created
5 programs.
