AN ACT PROHIBITING A MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE SURCHARGE FOR A FIRST OFFENSE CONVICTION OF SPEEDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 113P of chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out paragraph (c), as appearing in section 18
3 of chapter 266 of the acts of 1976, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following paragraph: —

5 (c) Twenty-five dollars — speeding for a second or subsequent
6 offense, and other moving traffic violations, but excluding operat-
7 ing without possession of a license or registration and such other
8 exclusions as provided by the commissioner.
