### AN ACT PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE IN EXCESS OF SPEED LIMITS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 17 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by chapter 151 of the acts of 1978, is hereby further  
3 amended by adding the following sentence: — Whoever violates  
4 any provision of this section shall be punished, for the first offense  
5 by a fine of not more than twenty-five dollars; and for the second  
6 and subsequent offenses occurring within a twelve month period of  
7 not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than fifty dollars for  
8 each such offense.
