AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO FILE AN ACCIDENT REPORT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 by inserting after the first sentence the following: —
