AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE JUDICIAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 20 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 1003 of the acts of 1973, is
3 hereby further amended by adding the following subdivision: —

4 4A. The Judicial Retirement Board. The retirement system es-
5 tablished for the members of the judiciary under the provisions of
6 sections 65A through E, inclusive, shall be managed by a retire-
7 ment board which shall have the general powers and duties set
8 forth in subdivision 5.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amend-
2 ed by inserting after section 65A the following section: —

3 65F. Any member of the judiciary who must conform with
4 section 65D of this chapter shall be eligible to receive the same
5 benefits which are delineated under sections 6, 7, 11, 12A, 12B and
6 12C of said chapter.
