AN ACT INCREASING THE PUNISHMENT FOR ASSAULT AND BATTERY COM-MITTED UPON CERTAIN PUBLIC SERVANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 13D, as most recently amended by chapter 680 of the
- 3 acts of 1975, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —
- 4 Section 13D. Whoever commits an assault and battery upon a
- 5 police officer, a fire fighter, a correction officer or an employee of 6 the registry of motor vehicles having police powers, or a public
- 6 the registry of motor vehicles having ponce powers, of a public school
- 7 school teacher or administrator, or any person in a public school
- 8 system having similar duties, or a sheriff, a deputy sheriff, a court
- 9 officer or a constable engaged in the performance of his duty, shall
- 10 be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for not more than
- 11 three years or by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars and
- 12 imprisonment in jail or a house of correction for not less than
- 13 ninety days nor more than two and one-half years.
