AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES, TOWNS, AND DISTRICTS TO CONTRACT FOR MUTUAL AID AMONG INSPECTORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after the paragraph inserted by chapter 575 of the acts
3 of 1978 the following paragraph: —

4 For mutual aid for the use of electrical, building, plumbing, gas
