AN ACT EXEMPTING PENSION INCOME FROM THE STATE INCOME TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 General Laws, as appearing in section 5 of chapter 555 of the acts of
- 3 1971, is hereby amended by adding the following subparagraph: —
- 4 (7) An amount equal to the income from a pension for any
- 5 retired individual.
