AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE PRACTICE OF OPTOMETRY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 112, Section 66, as last amended by Section 2 of Chap-
2 ter 339 of the Acts of 1934 is hereby amended by changing the
3 period at the end of the section to a comma and inserting thereafter
4 the words "or the fitting of contact lenses to the human eye."
