The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

AN ACT REQUIRING ALL STATE EMPLOYEES TO PAY THE FAIR MARKET VALUE FOR PARKING AT ALL STATE FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter One Hundred and Forty of the Acts of
2 Nineteen Hundred Thirty-Four and Chapter One Hundred Eighty-
3 Three of the Acts of One Hundred Sixty-Two are hereby re-
4 pealed.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary,
2 the Executive Office of Administration and Finance shall, in com-
3 pliance with the guidelines set forth in this section, promulgate
4 rules and regulations whereby all state employees shall pay the
5 assessed fair market value for parking of motor vehicles at all state
6 facilities located throughout the Commonwealth. Further, the
7 Executive Office of Administration and Finance shall determine
8 the fair market value for all employee motor vehicle parking at all
9 state facilities.

10 The provisions of this act shall apply to all state employees
11 except the following: (a) state employees who are employed at a
12 state facility where the assessed fair market value for parking is less
13 than \$10.00 per month.

14 A. The term "state employee" as used in this section shall be
15 defined as any person who is employed by the state for the purpose

16 of receiving wages and salaries, and including elected officials.

17 B. The term "fair market value" as used in this section shall be
18 defined as the assessed average commercial rate charged for parking
19 within a one mile radius from each state facility where employee
20 parking is available.

21 C. All sums received under this section shall be credited to the
22 Highway Fund.
