AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provision of any general or special law to the
2 contrary, Blue Shield shall be subject to suit and shall be subject to
3 the rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to chapter ninety-
4 three A of the General Laws.
