RESOLVE CREATING ENERGY SYNTHETICS THROUGH B10-MASS ALTERNATIVES.

1 Resolved, That a commission of 7, which will consist of 2
2 Representatives to be named by the Speaker, 1 Senator to be
3 named by the President of the Senate, a member of the Energy
4 Department of the State of Massachusetts, a member of the M.I.T.
5 Energy office, and a member of the Massachusetts Department of
6 Forestry Division, all to be named by the Governor. Said commis-
7 sion shall investigate areas of energy substitutes; to be directed by
8 the M.I.T. Energy office to improvise ways and means of separat-
9 ing the solid sludge from wet sewerage waste and combine this
10 product with the incineration of solid waste material.

11 This study is to be accompanied by an appropriation of not more
12 than \$50,000 and no monies shall be for salaries and/or for the
13 commission members.
