AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE STORAGE OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The first paragraph of section 39A of chapter 255 of the General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:
- 3 The officer placing the motor vehicle shall direct the owner or
- 4 operator of the garage with whom the vehicle is placed to remove
- 5 said vehicle to a garage or site within the city or town where the
- 6 accident occurred.
