AN ACT TO ABOLISH ALL NEWSPAPER, BILLBOARD, RADIO AND TELEVISION ADVERTISING FOR THE MASSACHUSETTS STATE LOTTERY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:
