AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT CLERK IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF SOUTHERN NORFOLK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 10 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by section 176 of chapter 478 of the acts of 1978, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the second and third paragraphs  
4 and inserting in place thereof the following paragraphs: —

5 Two assistant clerks with salaries payable by the commonwealth  
6 may be appointed in: —

- 7 fourth district court of Bristol
- 8 municipal court of Brookline
- 9 district court of Chelsea
- 10 first district court of Essex
- 11 district court of central Middlesex
- 12 first district court of northern Middlesex
- 13 district court of western Norfolk
- 14 district court of Peabody
- 15 third district court of Plymouth
- 16 fourth district court of Plymouth.

17 Three assistant clerks with salaries payable by the common-  
18 wealth may be appointed in: —

- 19 first district court of Barnstable
- 20 municipal court of the Brighton district
- 21 second district court of Bristol
- 22 district court of Hampshire

- 23 first district court of eastern Middlesex
- 24 second district court of eastern Middlesex
- 25 fourth district court of eastern Middlesex
- 26 district court of Newton
- 27 district court of Southern Norfolk
- 28 second district court of Plymouth
- 29 district court of Somerville.
