AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING COMPENSATION FOR OVERTIME SERVICES
RELATIVE TO MEMBERS OF THE POLICE FORCE OF THE METROPOLITAN
DISTRICT COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 62B of chapter 92 of the General Laws is hereby amend-
- 2 ed by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof
- 3 the following:
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, members of the
- 5 police force of the commission who perform service beyond their
- 6 regular hours of service, said service to include, but not be limited
- 7 to, court appearances made by officers on behalf of the Common-
- 8 wealth, shall be compensated therefor with pay at time and one half
- 9 of their regular hourly rate.
