AN ACT TO CREATE QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE APPELLATE TAX BOARD AND TO ALTER THEIR SALARIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of chapter 58A of the General Laws is amended by
2 inserting after the words "five members" in the first sentence the
3 words "who shall be licensed to practice in the courts of the
4 Commonwealth".

5 Said section one is amended further by striking out in the first
6 paragraph the words "twenty-nine thousand six hundred and ten
7 dollars" and inserting in place thereof the words "forty thousand
8 dollars" and by striking out in said first paragraph "twenty-seven
9 thousand four hundred and thirty-three dollars" and inserting in
10 place thereof the words "thirty-five thousand dollars".

11 Section one is amended by striking out in the fourth sentence of
12 the first paragraph the words "full time" and inserting in place
13 thereof the words "entire time."
