## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE SERVICES OF ANY EMPLOYEE SERVING IN A TEMPORARY POSITION IN THE OFFICE OF THE SERGEANT-AT-ARMS SHALL TERMINATE NOT LATER THAN TWO WEEKS AFTER THE GENERAL COURT PROROGUES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 17 of chapter 3 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by chapter 686 of the acts of 1962, is hereby further
- 3 amended by adding the following sentence: — The services of any
- 4 employee serving in a temporary position shall terminate not later
- 5 than two weeks after the general court prorogues.
