RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two members
2 of the senate, four members of the house of representatives, and
3 three persons appointed by the governor, is hereby established for
4 the purpose of making an investigation and study relative to the
5 transportation development improvement program, so-called, as
6 provided for by chapter four hundred and eighty-one of the acts of
7 nineteen hundred and seventy-nine. Said commission shall in the
8 course of its investigation and study determine whether or not the
9 provisions of said chapter four hundred and eighty-one are being
10 complied with by the commonwealth and by the cities and towns.
