AN ACT RELATING TO THE QUALIFICATIONS OF ADJUSTERS OF FIRE LOSSES TO DETERMINE ARSON-RELATED FIRES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 172 of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as amended by
2 chapter 703 of the acts of 1941, is hereby further amended by
3 inserting after the first sentence the following sentence: — The
4 commissioner shall be satisfied that appraisers and adjusters of fire
5 losses are qualified, by training, experience or study, to ascertain
6 the possibility, likelihood, and existence of fires which originated
7 by reason of arson.
