RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO REVISION OF THE TAX ON SALES OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three members
2 of the senate, five members of the house of representatives, the
3 secretary of the executive office of consumer affairs or his designee,
4 the commissioner of revenue or his designee, the registrar of motor
5 vehicles or his designee, and five persons to be appointed by the
6 governor, including a dealer in the retail sale of motor vehicles, is
7 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and
8 study relative to the need and feasibility of revising the laws impos-
9 ing a tax on the retail sale of motor vehicles.
