RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF CONSTRUCTING A WOOD REFINERY WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of three members
2 of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker and
3 two members of the Senate to be appointed by the Senate President
4 and one person to be appointed by the Governor is hereby estab-
5 lished for the purpose of an investigation and study relative to the
6 feasibility of constructing a wood refinery in the Commonwealth to
7 encourage the use of gasohol, while creating a better usage for
8 discarded underbrush and wood.
