RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING OFF-TRACK AND SPORTS BETTING WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission is hereby established to
2 study the feasibility of legalized off-track and sports betting in the
3 Commonwealth. Said commission shall consist of three members
4 of the House of Representatives, to be appointed by the Speaker,
5 one member of the Senate, to be appointed by the President, and
6 one member of the business community to be appointed by the
7 Governor.

8 The commission shall report its recommendations to the Gener-
9 al Court on or before December 10, 1980.
