

By Mr. Bly of Saugus, petition of Belden G. Bly, Jr. (by vote of the town) relative to the funding of salaries payable during the months of July and August to teachers and other professional employees of the school department in the town of Saugus. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FUNDING OF SALARIES PAYABLE DURING THE MONTHS OF JULY AND AUGUST TO TEACHERS AND OTHER PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES OF THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT IN THE TOWN OF SAUGUS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the  
2 contrary, the Town of Saugus may exclude from its budget for the  
3 fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty the  
4 estimated amounts earned by teachers or any other professional  
5 employees of the school department for the school year ending on  
6 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty, which are actually  
7 payable during the months of July and August of the year nineteen  
8 hundred and eighty; said Town of Saugus shall budget for the fiscal  
9 year commencing July first, nineteen hundred and eighty, one-half  
10 of the amounts necessary to make payments during the months of  
11 July and August, nineteen hundred and eighty-one, of monies  
12 earned by teachers and any other professional employees for the  
13 school year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty,  
14 and for the fiscal year commencing July first, nineteen hundred  
15 and eighty-one, the full amounts necessary to make payments  
16 during the months of July and August, nineteen hundred and

17 eighty-one, of monies earned by teachers and any other profession-  
18 al employees for the school year ending June thirtieth, nineteen  
19 hundred and eighty-two, which, in effect, will mean a thirteen-  
20 month budget for school salaries in each of the fiscal years in  
21 question; but, the excess over the twelve-month budget for school  
22 salaries in each fiscal year shall be appropriated by special article in  
23 the Town Meeting for each respective year and said amounts so  
24 appropriated shall not be subject to chapter one hundred fifty-one  
25 of the acts of nineteen hundred seventy-nine limiting local appro-  
26 priations or any successor acts.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
