AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE CITY OF ALLSTON-BRIGHTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby established a municipality to be  
2 known as the city of Allston-Brighton. Said municipality shall  
3 consist of former ward twenty-two and precincts two to sixteen of  
4 ward twenty-one in the city of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the voters of said  
2 territory and be placed on an official ballot at a special election in  
3 the form of the following question: "Shall an act passed by the  
4 General Court in the year nineteen hundred and seventy-nine  
5 entitled 'an act establishing the city of Allston-Brighton', be  
6 accepted?" If a majority of votes in the affirmative is voted this act  
7 shall take effect July first, nineteen hundred and eighty-one.
