AN ACT INCREASING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any person entitled to a real estate property tax abatement
2 under the provisions of clauses twenty-second to twenty-second E,
3 inclusive, of section five of chapter fifty-nine of the General Laws,
4 is hereby entitled to an additional exemption equal to the sum
5 provided for in the said clause for which he is entitled to such
6 original abatement.
