AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING FOREIGN LICENSEES AUTHORIZED TO EXPORT OR SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO DOMESTIC LICENSEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 18B of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as amended by  
2 section 1 of chapter 279 of the acts of 1974, is hereby further  
3 amended by striking out, in line 1, the word "shall" and inserting in  
4 place thereof the word: — may and by striking out in line 4, the  
5 word "shall" and inserting in place thereof the word: — may.

THE FOREIGN INVESTMENT IN THE UNITED STATES ACT OF 1946

IN SENATE, FEBRUARY 1, 1947.

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND COMMERCE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

1. Section 101 of the Act defines the term "foreign investment" as any investment in the United States of funds or property of a foreign country, or of a foreign individual or corporation, which is made for the purpose of acquiring or increasing the ownership of any interest in any business, industry, or enterprise in the United States.
