## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE SALE OF FLAMMABLE SLEEPWEAR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 148 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking  
2 out section 25D and inserting in place thereof the following sec-  
3 tion: —  
4 *Section 25D.* The board shall make rules and regulations relating  
5 to the manufacture and sale of sleepwear of all sizes and clothing for  
6 children up to and including size fourteen, which rules and regula-  
7 tions may specifically prohibit the sale or manufacture of any such  
8 clothing or sleepwear which it deems to be a fire hazard or which fails  
9 to meet the specification of self-extinguishing when the source of  
10 ignition is removed.
