The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE STRIKING OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary, an insurance company providing motor vehicle insur-
3 ance shall report to the registrar of motor vehicles the motor
4 vehicle identification number of any motor vehicle on which said
5 insurance company has declared said vehicle a total loss and has
6 paid the registered owner thereof as such on his property damage
7 insurance. Upon receipt of any such identification number, said
8 registrar shall cause said number to be stricken from the computer
9 records of the registry of motor vehicles.
