AN ACT REQUIRING OWNERS OF TAXICABS TO CARRY INCREASED AMOUNTS OF LIABILITY INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 22 of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by section 1 of chapter 694 of the acts of 1968, is hereby
- 3 further amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 No license under this section shall be granted to the owner of any
- 5 taxicab unless the owner presents satisfactory proof of binding
- 6 liability insurance in minimum amounts of one hundred thousand
- 7 dollars for each person and two hundred thousand dollars for each
- 8 accident covering each taxicab so licensed.
