**AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE LICENSING OF OPERATORS OF MOTORIZED BICYCLES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting  
2 after section 8K the following section: —

3 *Section 8K.* Application for a license to operate a motorized  
4 bicycle as defined in section one B of said chapter ninety may be  
5 made by any person who shall have attained the age of eighteen  
6 years; but before such a person shall be so licensed the registrar  
7 shall be satisfied that he is of good moral character and has  
8 successfully completed a driving performance test and a visual test  
9 as shall be determined by the registrar.

10 Any such license or special permit issued under the provisions of  
11 this section shall be valid for a period of twenty-four months from  
12 date of issue.

13 The registrar may suspend or revoke a license granted under  
14 authority of this section for a violation of any of the provisions of  
15 this chapter, or any other reasonable grounds, or where in his  
16 opinion the licensee is either physically or morally unfit to retain  
17 the same.

18 The registrar may make such rules and regulations as he may  
19 deem necessary to carry out the provisions of this section.
