The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ANY MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICER'S POWER TO ARREST SHALL EXTEND THROUGHOUT THE COMMONWEALTH FOR FELONIES COMMITTED IN THE PRESENCE OF SAID MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 98 of chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by adding the following paragraph: —
- 3 The chief and other police officers of all cities and towns who are
- 4 empowered to make arrests within a city or town may exercise such
- 5 authority in any other city or town for any felony committed in
- 6 their presence while on official assignment in the line of duty.
